

New and Updated Staff Roles for 2019

Trip Logistics Specialist

The Trip Logi Specialist carries out the daily operations and organization of the trip center, as well as trip preparations and pack out/pack in processes. They support a small team of Trip Support staff to carry out these tasks.

Program Staff

Program Staff will work closely with the FT On-Site Program Coordinators to assist in the daily programming of Main Camp and Teen Programs. Program staff will be responsible for planning and executing special camp activities, evening programs and morning reflections. They will additionally assist in assigning cabin groups and service tasks as well as helping to plan Olympics.

High Ropes Specialist

The High Ropes Specialist will oversee the use of the High Ropes course and Power Pole, primarily supporting teen programs. In addition, they will help with facilitation of team elements for Main Camp cabins. The High Ropes Specialist will also oversee the coordination of overnights for Main Camp.

Teen Wilderness Unit Leader

The Teen Wilderness Director oversees all wilderness teen programs (Voyagers, RANGERS) to ensure the physical and emotional well-being of all campers and staff. The Teen Wilderness Director, in collaboration with the Teen Leadership Director, works closely with the summer leadership team and supervise all Teen Leadership staff to meet these goals. *Similar to the Main Camp Directors, the emphasis on this role is well being of campers and staff in teen programs.*

Teen Leadership Unit Leader

The Teen Leadership Director oversees all teen leadership programs (TYC, Villagers, LIT, CIT) to ensure the physical and emotional well-being of all campers and staff. The Teen Leadership Director, in collaboration with the Teen Wilderness Director, works closely with the summer leadership team and supervise all Teen Wilderness staff to meet these goals. *Similar to the Main Camp Directors, the emphasis on this role is well being of campers and staff in teen programs.*

Teen Leadership Staff

The Teen Leadership staff work together to provide direction and supervision to teen campers, ensuring the physical and emotional well-being of the rising 9th grade campers in the Villagers service program and the rising 10th grade campers in the LIT (Leaders in Training) program. Staff will plan and execute the programs with guidance from the Teen Leadership Director and live in the cabin space with campers.

CIT Staff

The CIT Staff will no longer be responsible for overnights as to provide more time for CIT observation and guidance. The CIT Staff will also be expected to live in the cabin space with campers or with another teen group.

Senior Area Head Roles

In summer 2019, Senior Area Heads may be expected to live with teen groups in Village cabins or large peak cabins (Foster, Peak 12, Horse Haven) and assist in providing extra supervision at night time.

Senior Swimming Area Head

The swimming area head positions will now have a Senior Out of Cabin area head and a co- area head who is also a senior counselor. The senior area head will support the waterfront during all cabin groups and serve as the fun swim manager.
